

MPA State Vice President - Eastern District

To be eligible for this office, the candidate must be a MPA member in good standing for at least one year.

The individual who is elected to this position will represent the MPA members of the Eastern District of Montana and hold a position on the MPA state Board of Directors.

The Eastern District is defined by the area **East** of the 111° 30 latitude, which is a north/south line passing just to the west of Great Falls, continuing south and just east of Ennis. The area represented includes **Havre, Great Falls, Bozeman, West Yellowstone, Miles City, Glendive, and all cities and residents east of the 111° 30 longitude.**

The responsibilities of the Eastern V.P. are as follows:

This individual along with the other members of the Board of Directors shall have full power and authority to exercise all corporate functions conferred upon the organization by law, and in addition to such general powers, they shall have the power and authority to do all things herein specified, subject to any regulations made by the membership, and in addition the Board of Directors shall be empowered to:

- A.** Establish amount and disbursement of annual dues in accordance with Article V.
- B.** Authorize and provide for the institution of individual Hangars of the Montana Pilots' Association, Inc. within the State of Montana.
- C.** Refuse to accept or renew the membership of any individual for conduct or acts prejudicial to the best interest of the organization

In addition: A Vice-President shall exercise all of the powers of the President during the President's absence or disability. The one Vice-President serving in that capacity will be determined by the President.

Board of Director Meetings: The Board of Directors shall meet at least three (3) times each year in addition to the annual meeting. The first such meeting will be held within ninety (90) days following the annual meeting. Special meetings may be called by the State President by giving two weeks' notice to all members of the Board. Special meetings may be conducted electronically (not physically attended). The State MPA shall bear the cost of setting up and conducting all electronically scheduled special meetings. Members of the State Board of Directors who are absent from two (2) consecutive meetings of the Board without presenting a reason acceptable to the Board shall be deemed to have resigned and the office shall be declared vacant.

Currently, Board of Director meetings are conducted in Helena and usually on a Saturday. Locations for these meetings are subject to change.

Length of Term: One (1) year
